Background

- June 3, 2013, La Canada City Council adopted a resolution in support of a transfer of territory to the La Canada Unified School District boundaries
 - The “Territory” comprises the portion of the City of La Canada Flintridge west of Rosebank Dr. to the LCF westernmost boundary of Pickens Canyon and generally north of Foothill Blvd.
 - Discussions regarding a potential Territory transfer have been on-going between GUSD and LCUSD throughout the 2013-2014 school year.
- Schools affected by the proposed transfer area:
 - Mountain Avenue Elementary School
 - Rosemont Middle School
 - Crescenta Valley High School

Impacts and Interests

- If a potential Territory transfer is to move forward, the following impacts and interests need to be reconciled:
 - Student Phase-In (six-year permissive plan)
 - School Facilities – Capacity and Enrollment Issues
 - GUSD General Obligation Bonds – Mitigate Impacts
 - Revenue and Expenditure Effects
