

TERRITORY TRANSFER TIMELINE

Late June 2016	A group of residents from the territory known as Sagebrush calling themselves <i>UniteLCF</i> submitted a petition to transfer students from Glendale Unified School District (GUSD) to La Cañada Unified School District (LCUSD) to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder for certification.
July 26, 2016	The UniteLCF petition was certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder, meaning it reached the signature requirement and will move on to the Los Angeles County Office of Education.
Sept 7, 2016	LA County election officials presented the UniteLCF petition to the Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization.
Sept-Nov 2016	One public hearing was held by the County Committee in each affected school district - GUSD and LCUSD.
Nov-Dec 2016	County Committee staff gathered data, prepared a feasibility study of the area, and formulated plans and recommendations as to whether or not the territory should be transferred based on specified criteria contained in Ed. Code 35753.
May 2017	The County Committee voted, against County Committee staff recommendation, to preliminarily approve the territory transfer petition pending a CEQA review.
January 2018	The County Committee selected environmental services consultant Terry Hayes and Associates to complete the CEQA review for the territory transfer.
May 2018	County Committee staff updated the County Committee that Terry Hayes and Associates are continuing to work on the CEQA review. At the completion of the study, the County Committee may take its final vote on the territory transfer petition.

GUSD will continue to update this timeline as we receive new information.
