- Positive approach to shaping behavior. Students are given a clear set of expectations based upon behavioral goals chosen by staff members.
- Behavioral expectations are taught just like an academic subject. Expectations are modeled then practiced by students
- Motivational incentives are identified and utilized to drive expected behaviors.
