- Stay on campus during your scheduled “on campus” class time
- Follow appropriate safety protocols based on GUSD recommendations.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

- Ensure your child attends school daily.
- Review and enforce the school dress code
- Provide a quiet place and time for your child to study each day.
- Encourage your child to complete homework assignments and to prepare for quizzes and tests; check their progress daily.
- Communicate with counselor, administrator, teacher, or Teacher Specialist when concerns or questions arise regarding grades, attendance, and/or behavior.
- Attend parent/guardian meetings.
- Utilize Parent Connect to check grades, assignments and daily attendance
- Utilize Glendale High website (www.glendalehigh.com) to access information.
- Review and enforce GUSD safety protocols

Teacher Responsibilities:

- Provide high quality curriculum and instruction aligned to Common Core State Standards.
- Refer the student to the appropriate educational guidance services.
- Maintain contact with parent/guardians to provide information on student progress, as needed.
- Meet with student-parent/guardian-teacher to confer on student progress, as needed.
