- Explains student's placement and services they will receive (if any)

## ANNUAL NOTIFICATION LETTER

- All English Learners' families once per year
- Summative ELPAC and CAASPP score reports
- Types of programs offered for English Learners
- Reclassification Criteria
- Discloses parents' rights and opportunities for input
- Alerts if student is LTEL or At Risk of LTEL

## WHAT IS ELD?

## **ELD** = **E**nglish **L**anguage **D**evelopment



Required <u>daily</u> English instruction provided to all English Learners



To help students learn English as quickly as possible to understand and use both academic and social language



Equity and access to curriculum, and to be college and career ready

### **BRIDGING**


- Applying high-level language skills in a variety of contexts

### **Program 1**

- Immersive ELD instruction
- Only ELD grades
- Max. of 2 yrs

### Program 2

- ELD & Grade Level ELA
- ELD & ELA grades
- 2-4 yrs





- Required Daily (California Education for a Global Economy (Ed.G.E.)
   Initiative (Proposition 58).
- Delivered by classroom or ELD teacher
- Students learn how English works as well as skills to help them in all classes
- Based on <u>2012 CA ELD Standards</u>



### **INTEGRATED ELD**



- Required Daily
- Delivered by classroom or content area teacher
- Students learn academic English through content areas

## ENGLISH LEARNER FACILITATED LEARNING CENTERS

- Started Nov 16
- By invitation only
- Secondary sites
- Emerging students
- 10 or fewer students in each FLC
- Same schedule/teachers
- Substitute teacher and Ed Assistant
- Outdoor activities



## **RECLASSIFICATION CRITERIA**

- Students monitored for four years
- Intervention if necessary
- Often, reclassified students out-perform their English-only peers

  order these Pre-ID labels; they will be sent to the LEAs to return paper-scorable materials.


