

Board of Education Priorities

Maximize Student Achievement

- · Close the digital and equity gap
- Offer robust distance, hybrid, and in-person learning programs
- · Address learning loss and improve attendance

Foster a Positive Culture of Learning

- · Ensure equitable teaching and learning opportunities led by excellence
- · Support culturally relevant curriculum that emphasizes inclusion
- Increase parent and family engagement opportunities

Ensure the Health and Safety of Students and Employees

- · Strengthen mental health support and programs
- Develop proactive health and safety procedures
- · Support physical, social, and emotional wellbeing

Maintain District Financial Responsibility

- · Ensure the fiscal health of the district

Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Goals

Maximize Student Achievement

- 1-1: Improve academic achievement for all students.
- 1-2: Ensure all students are college and/or career ready upon graduation.

Create a Culture of Learning

- 2-1: Support the social, emotional, and physical needs of all students.
- 2-2: Provide services and conditions that support student learning.
- 2-3: Provide teachers with tools and training to implement State academic standards.
- 2-4: Provide students with access to support interventions and instructional technology for learning.

Increase Engagement

- 3-1: Create a positive environment and opportunities for students to connect with their school and community.
- 3-2: Engage families and community to support student learning.



- A tool to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to improve student outcomes
- A required component of California's Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)
- Must address the eight state priorities and any local priorities set by the local governing board
- Must address specific identified needs of students who are low income, English Learners, and foster youth (i.e. unduplicated students)
- Must include a description of the annual goals to be achieved
- Must include an annual review of the effectiveness of the goals, actions, and services

LCFF State Priorities

- 1. Appropriate teacher assignment, sufficient instructional materials, and facilities in good repair
- 2. Implementation of academic content and performance standards adopted by the State Board of Education (SBE)
- 3. Parental Involvement and Family Engagement

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- 4. Student Achievement
- 5. Student Engagement
- 6. School Climate
- 7. Course Access
- 8. Other Student Outcomes
