# ELEMENTARY English Learner Reclassification Criteria

*All four of the criteria must be met for a student to be reclassified as fluent English proficient. EC Section 313(f)*

**Criteria 1:**  
**Score of 4 Overall on the Summative ELPAC\***

\*English Language Proficiency Assessments for California



**Criteria 2:**  
**Comparison of Basic Skills**

*This is used to help determine if a student is likely to achieve comparably in a classroom of English-only peers, using Glendale Unified adopted curricula.  
 For Grades 3-6, students can reclassify using **Option 1**, **Option 2**, or **Option 3** (Option 3 is only for students with IEPs)*

**Parent Input/Consultation**

*(Solicited by letter or conference)*
