Q: If we are going to unenroll and go to private school who do we inform?

A: Parents should inform their school site and be ready to fill out a withdrawal form.

Q: Is EEELP (childcare) available during the online distance learning model?

A: Technology Learning Pods (TLPs) at all 20 elementary schools were developed in response to parents' requests for childcare during distance learning. Assignment of students to a TLP was done on a priority basis to: 1) Existing GUSD families enrolled in the state-subsidized child care program; 2) Foster/Homeless youth; 3) Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch; 4) Children of GUSD employees; 5) Other students as space and staffing permitted. All TLPs are full. Contact the EEELP Office (818) 247-0775, to be added to the waiting list.

Q: Will we have access to child's progress on weekly basis?

A: Progress reports are provided to parents every 5 weeks at the secondary level and each trimester at the elementary level for those students performing below grade level.

Q: Are all classes going to be books & materials or is it just going to be online?

A: Students will have access to books and other materials during distance learning. These materials will be distributed from the students' school.

Q: If a student is enrolled in the CCRC program and as long as the schools are closed is that possible for the child to continue visiting the pre-school daycare center or is there another programs or centers that GUSD is suggesting for now considering that both parents are working?

A: Parents who have questions about preschool enrollment and enrollment through CCRC should contact the EEELP Office at 818-247-0775 to discuss their situation.

Q: How can we get the results of our child's ELPAC exam?

A: School site Teacher Specialists can provide you with a copy of your child's ELPAC scores.

Q: Will there be an in-person orientation?

A: There will not be an in-person orientation, but you may join any of the remaining virtual meetings held on Wednesdays through August 26, 2020.

Q: Can we use Macbooks?

A: Yes, students can use their own device for Distant Learning.

Q: How do we find out when Back to School Night is?

A: Your school should send out information regarding Back to School Night once school begins. This information will also be posted on your school's website.

Q: When will schools notify parents of new parent orientation?

A: Information regarding scheduled orientations will be sent out by your child's school soon.

Q: When will parents be able to see the teachers?

A: Each school schedules different opportunities for parents and students. Please check your school's website and look for school communications via email and phone blasts.

Q: How soon can we complete the meal application?

A: Meal applications are available now to complete.

Q: How many hours the online classes for 5 year old?

A: Schedules for TK-12th grade instructional days will be shared once finalized.

A: Each school will be communicating information regarding their back to school nights once school begins.

A: Chromebooks are being distributed to students at their respective school sites. Schedules for pick up dates and times have been shared with families.

A: Beginning August 19th all schools will be in distance learning.
