- Of Toll's 33 inter-district permits, 5 are for the FLAG programs currently housed at the school. All 5 are enrolled in the Spanish Dual program.

Considerations

- Have to find the right combination of dual programs and projected non-dual student population to not exceed the school's capacity and to balance enrollment between the four middle schools
 - Non-Dual + Dual = Total Student Population
- Movement between schools would be treated the same as current GUSD transfer requests, on a case-by-case basis and pending available space
- Attrition rates may be affected by the location of the program, however many parents have expressed a strong commitment to following the program regardless of location
