

What is the SAMR Model?

• The Substitution, Augmentation, Modification, Redefinition (SAMR) model categorizes four different degrees of classroom technology integration as an instructional approach aimed at meeting divergent learning needs ranging from remediation to enrichment.

 It ensures instructional technology is used to enhance learning, foster creativity, and facilitate access to rigorous prompts.



The SAMR Initiative

- The 2020-21 SAMR Initiative offered educators an opportunity to develop blended learning and instructional technology knowledge and expertise to become a Technology Coach to Enhance Instruction (TCEI) at their school sites.
- The TCEI leader serves as an instructional technology lead
- TCEIs support educators in incorporating technology as a tool to differentiate teaching and learning through 21st century innovative approaches.



Elements of the GUSD SAMR Initiative

- Six modules that moved gradually from theory to practice
- Expectation to plan and lead school-site trainings
- Completion of Google Certification Level I or II
- Service as instructional technology leaders
- Participation by 29 educators
- Collaborative initiative with Teaching & Learning, Education
 Technology & Information Services, and Innovation, Instruction,
 Assessment & Accountability
