2021-22 School Year Update

- Return to in-person learning for all students, five days a week, full school days.
- District will remain consistent with LA County Department of Public Health guidance. LACDPH has committed to remain consistent with CA Department of Public Health guidance.
- Glendale Unified Independent Study Program will be offered for students who cannot return to school.



Glendale Unified Independent Study

- Option for eligible students whose health or other personal circumstances make returning to on-campus instruction difficult.
- School staff will refer parents/guardians to Student Support Services for an intake meeting.
- Students with exceptional needs may only be enrolled in an Independent Study program if their individualized education program (IEP) specifically provides for such enrollment (EC 56026).
- Independent study courses will be taught under the general supervision of certificated teachers who will provide curriculum and lesson packets and check in regularly with students.
- Students will have rights to return to their home school for the 2022-23 school year.
