Summer Deep Cleaning

Classrooms

- High and low dusting of surfaces.
- Damp-wipe light fixtures, vents, and blinds.
- Wash walls, woodwork, and doors.
- Damp-wipe and spot clean counter tops and cabinets.
- Clean whiteboards; remove staples and wipe corkboards.
- Wash desks, tables, and chairs; remove graffiti, gum, tape, and stickers; replace/repair damaged or missing parts.
- Scour sinks and dispensers; replace any broken dispensers.
- Sweep and mop floors; vacuum rugs and carpeting.






Summer Deep Cleaning

Restrooms

- Wash walls and woodwork with disinfectant cleaner.
- Remove paper wads and graffiti from walls and ceilings.
- Scour sinks, toilets, and urinals to remove hard water deposits on porcelain.
- Sanitize flush valves and plumbing fixtures.
- Wipe down and sanitize all dispensers; replace broken dispensers.

Locker and Shower Rooms

- Remove all discarded clothing from lockers and floor.
- Power-wash all tile walls in shower areas to remove soap scum and hard water deposits.
- Wash down walls, lockers, and showers with disinfectant.
- Machine scrub all concrete locker room and shower floors with disinfectant.





Summer Deep Cleaning

Auditoriums

- High dusting, cleaning walls and woodwork.
- Wipe down, clean underneath, and remove graffiti from all seats.
- Sweep and mop stage areas and clear areas of any fire hazards.
- Remove items in storage and debris from stage.
- Sweep and mop floors; vacuum carpeting.

Libraries

- Dust all shelves and tops of bookshelves.
- High and low dusting of all surfaces.
- Clean and disinfect counter tops and sinks.
- Dust light fixtures and diffusers.
- Sweep and mop floors; vacuum carpeting.

Kitchens and Cafeterias

- Damp-wipe hoods inside and outside.
- Wipe down cabinets, counter tops, and hard ceilings.
- Clean in-wall tables and table storage.
- Sweep and mop floors, stage, and storage areas.
- Wash walls, woodwork, and doors with multi-purpose cleaner; deep clean sinks with disinfectant.
- Replace burned-out light bulbs.

Building Exteriors

- Hose down all exterior walls, doors, window frames to remove cobwebs and dirt.
- Washed and squeegee-clean all windows.
- Pressure-wash exterior concrete walkways, stairs, and lunch areas to remove gum and dirt.
