 - Academic programs based on identified student need
- Free for all participating families
- Primarily in-person, located at school sites
- Funded by AB86, Title III, and other grant funds

Summer Expanded Learning Goals

Support students, employees, and families by providing:

- Accelerated academic progress to close learning gaps
 - Emphasis on English Learners, homeless, foster, low-income youth
- In-person enrichment and social interaction for students
- Child care option for families
- Additional paid opportunities for teachers and staff



Targeted Expanded Learning Programs



High School Expanded Learning (Summer School)

- June 14 - July 16 (two sessions)
- Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 1:15 p.m.
- Available at all high schools, including Clark Magnet
- In-person program
 - Distance learning option may be available to expand programs to more students
- Credit recovery for core courses and electives
- Support for students with special needs
- Opportunities for acceleration



Middle School Expanded Learning (Summer School)

- June 14 - July 16
- Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
- Available at all middle schools
- In-person program
- Support for students with special needs
- 4-period day
 - Math
 - English Language Arts (ELA) / English Language Development (ELD)
 - 2 electives / enrichment (ie: art, music, foods, technology)

Offerings will vary by school site



Elementary Expanded Learning Camp EXCEL (**EX**cited to **C**onnect, **E**ngage & **L**earn!)

- June 14 - July 2
- Monday - Friday, 8:30 - 11:45 a.m.
 - Child care before and after
- Available at all elementary schools
- In-person program
- Core classes: Math, English Language Arts, English Language Development
- Enrichment: May include dual immersion, science/STEAM, physical education, visual and performing arts, social emotional learning



Elementary Extended School Year (ESY)

- June 14 - July 15
- Monday - Thursday, 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
- Available at Cerritos (social skills), Columbus, Lincoln, Mann
- In-person program
- Targeted support for students with special needs
- Focus on academic instruction and building social skills
