

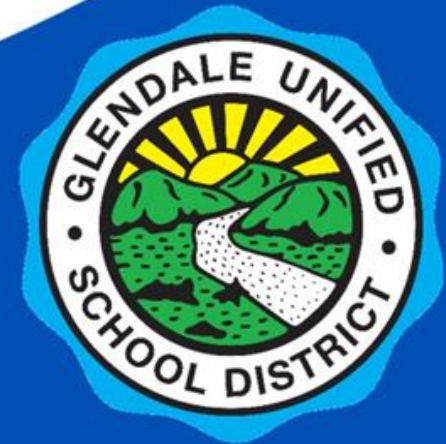

Distance Learning vs. Blended Learning

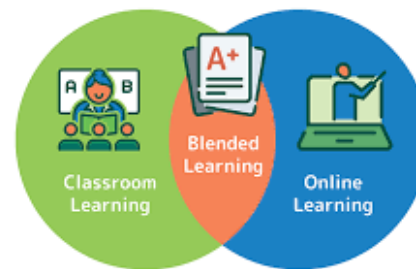
Distance Learning

- Tech tools used to:
 - Enhance engagement
 - Organize virtual classroom
 - Provide feedback
 - Monitor progress
 - Students learn from home

Blended Learning

- Tech tools used to:
 - Accelerate learning
 - Differentiate support
 - Provide actionable feedback
 - Facilitate higher order thinking
 - Engage students in collaboration
 - Provide rigorous learning opportunities
 - Students learn partly through online delivery of content and instruction
