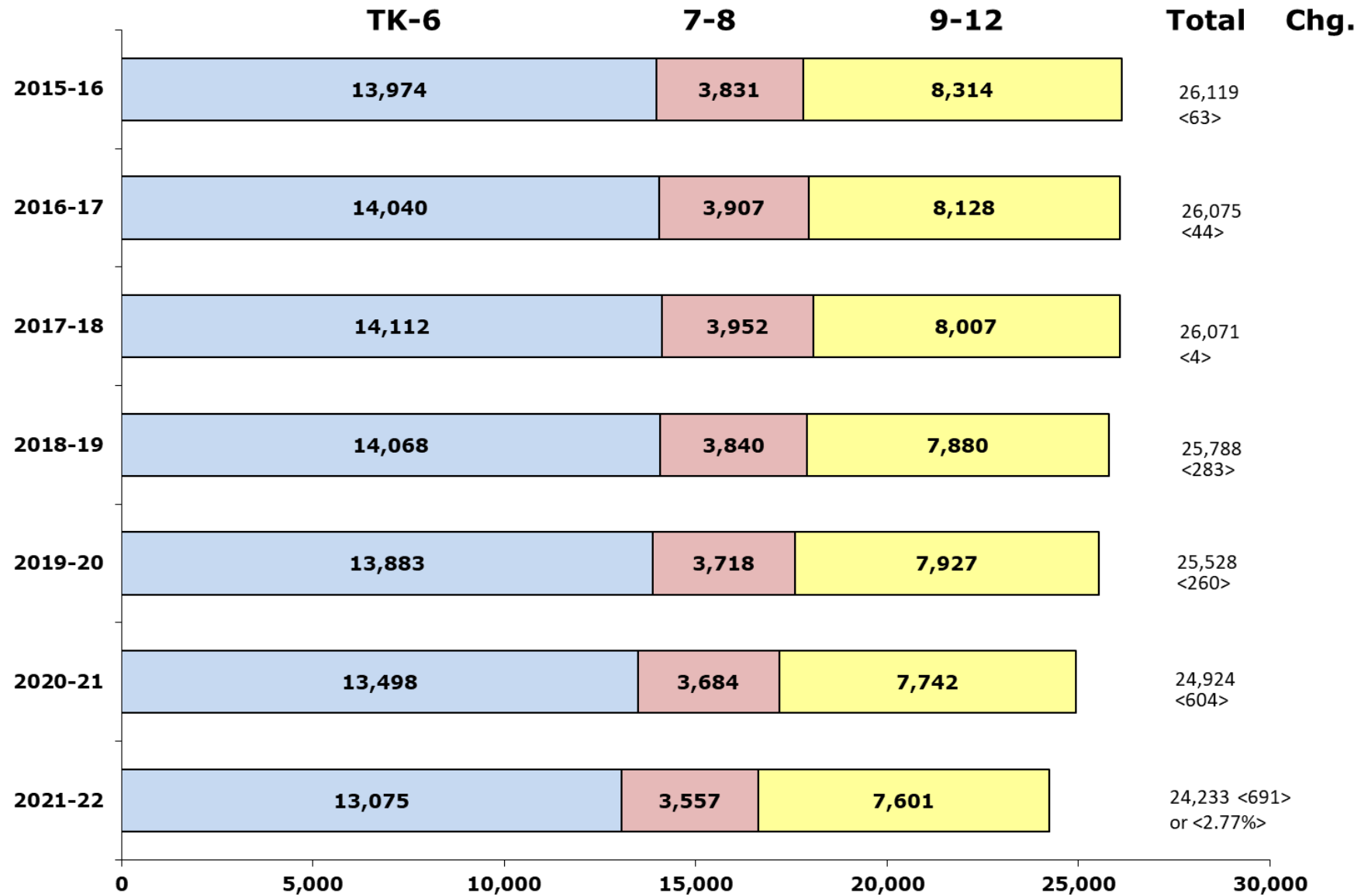

# Student Enrollment

- GUSD enrolls and dis-enrolls students on a continuous basis
- In 2020-2021 GUSD enrolled 2,570 new students
- In 2021-2022 GUSD has so far enrolled 2,730 new students

# Student Enrollment

## Students Who Did Not Continue in 2021-2022

- 1,007 students who were enrolled in the 2020-2021 did not return for the 2021-2022 school year
- Out of 1,007 students, 855 were residents of Glendale and 152 were enrolled in GUSD on an inter-district permit
- Parents can choose to not renew an inter-district permit
- 620 students or 61.57% of the 1,007 total students who did not return to GUSD were in TK-6 during the 2020-2021 school year.
- 387 students from grades 7-11 left the District

# Student Enrollment

## Students Who Did Not Continue in 2021-2022

- 465 students enrolled in another California public school
- 168 of these students enrolled in schools within 25 miles of GUSD for the 2021-2022 school year



# Student Enrollment

## Students Who Enrolled in Private Schools within 25 Miles of GUSD

- 145 students left GUSD to attend private schools
- 134 of these students are/were residents of Glendale
- Most of the private schools they enrolled in are within 25 miles from GUSD
- The highest number of students who left this school year for private school are now attending Village Christian or Rose & Alex Pilibos Armenian School
- Of these 145 students, 83 are in elementary school grades, 47 are in middle school grades, and 15 are in high school grades
