Action Item No. 5

Approval of Credit Change Order No. 1 to Bid No. 171-17/18 with Cybertech Construction Co. for LED Lighting Upgrades at Various School Sites and a Notice of Completion

- On May 15, 2018, the Board approved the award of Bid No. 171/17/18 for LED lighting upgrades at various sites to Cybertech Construction Co. in the amount of \$46,936.25
 - Sites included Toll, Roosevelt, Wilson, Rosemont Middle, and Glendale High Schools
- Change Order No. 1 for a credit of \$1,116.25 accounts for a reduction in the scope of work on the project
 - The District felt it best to forgo a portion of the work outside the 3000 building at Wilson
 - o Change Order represents a decrease of 2.38% of the original contract
 - Decreases the original contract total to \$45,820
- Project was completed in a satisfactory manner as of September 20, 2019 and was funded by Proposition 39 funds






Approval of Notice of Completion for Bid No. 205-20/21 with Trueline Construction & Surfacing, Inc. for Tennis Court Refurbish & Resurface Project at Glendale High School

- On November 2, 2020, the Board approved the award of Bid No. 205-20/21 to Trueline Construction & Surfacing, Inc. for the tennis court refurbish and resurface project at Glendale High School in the amount of \$89,200
 - There were no Change Orders on this project
- The project was completed in a satisfactory manner as of January 13, 2021, and funded by Routine Restricted Maintenance – GHS Tennis Court Renovation Project funds




