### Action Item No. 6

#### Award of Bid No. 215-20/21 for Roofing Projects at Two (2) School Sites

 A job walk was conducted for the roofing projects at Franklin and Fremont Elementary Schools and four (4) bids were received and opened on May 26, 2021 as noted below

Contractor	Franklin ES	Fremont ES
Stone Roofing Company, Inc.	\$192,800	\$217,900
Letner Roofing Co.	\$205,609	\$321,393
Best Contracting Services, Inc.	\$222,975	\$226,700
Rey-Crest Waterproofing Co.	\$326,725	\$542,246

- Staff is recommending to award the bid to Stone Roofing Company, Inc. at Franklin Elementary School for \$192,800 and at Fremont Elementary School for \$217,900
- Anticipated completion is by August 10, 2021
- Funded by Measure S Annual Deferred Maintenance (Summer Projects) funds



#### Action Item No. 7

Approval of Independent Consultant Agreement No. 618 with BPI Inspection Services for the Verdugo Woodlands Elementary School Bridge Project's DSA Inspection Services

- On February 5, 2019, the Board approved a budget allocation of \$2,000,000 for the Verdugo Woodlands Bridge Project
  - o On May 18, 2021, the Board approved a budget adjustment in the amount of \$1,250,000, resulting in a total project budget of \$3,250,000
- Staff obtained a proposal from BPI Inspection Services to provide DSA-required project inspection services
  - This proposal is for a not-to-exceed amount of \$123,420
  - This represents 3.80% of the total project costs and is included in the approved project budget
- Staff is recommending the approval of ICA No. 618 with BPI for \$123,420
- Funded by Measure S Verdugo Woodlands New Bridge Project
