

C-CAP LA 2023 Summer Job Training and Internship Program



What are YOU doing this summer??

Do you want to improve your culinary skills?

Do you want to work in a professional kitchen?

Do you want to gain REAL work experience?

Each Summer C-CAP offers Culinary Job Training classes that culminate with a tour of the Santa Monica Farmers Market with great, local chefs, followed by paid internships. After 7 days of training (classroom & kitchen classes, field trips, guest speaking events, etc.), successful students are hired to work 5-to-7-week internships, in restaurants or other professional kitchens.

Interns work approximately 30-35 hours per week and earn minimum wage. Interns are required to complete 175 hours of work and commit to the internship.

** Are at least 16 years of age by June 29, 2023*

**For Internships - Are legally allowed to work in the United States with social security number and government issued photo ID (your high school ID is fine)*

*** You are not required to take an internship!!*

**Are willing to commit to all days of Job Training (MUST ATTEND ALL DAYS) and working 175 hours in the summer with no absences if you plan on taking an internship*
