Integrated Pest Management

The Board of Education recognizes the potential health hazards associated by the presence of vermin and pests in District facilities.

It is the policy of the Board of Education that the most effective and least toxic pest management practices be the preferred method of managing pests encountered at District facilities.

In order to reduce exposure during periods of pesticide use, the Superintendent/designee shall take the necessary steps to ensure that the most effective and least toxic pest management practices are implemented as prescribed by Education Code, Sections 17608-17613 (Healthy Schools Act of 2000).
