Naming/Dedication of School Facilities

Naming of School Facilities

Naming of all schools, school buildings, special purpose rooms, athletic fields, quads, playgrounds and other campus facilities and areas in the District is subject to approval by the Board of Education in recognition of:

- a. Individuals, living or deceased, who have made exemplary contributions to the school district and/or community;
- b. Individuals, living or deceased, who have made contributions of county, state, national or worldwide significance;
- c. The geographic area in which the facility is located.

Requests for the naming of schools and school facilities as specified above may originate from the school district or community. They will be referred to the Superintendent for review and recommendation to the Board.

Memorials and Recognitions

- a. With approval of a school principal and Superintendent designee, a plaque or other appropriate memorial may be placed on a building, portion of a building, classroom, athletic field or other area on campus in commemoration of an individual, living or deceased, who has contributed to the school or school district.
- b. The Superintendent or designee shall be informed by the school principal or designee in advance of the placement of a plaque or other memorial on a school campus.
