Franklin Elementary School 2-Story Classroom Building Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Glendale, CA – A ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the completion of the new 2-story classroom building at Franklin Elementary School will be held on Thursday, April 7, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. at Franklin Elementary School located at 1610 Lake Street, Glendale, CA 91201.

The project was funded through Measure S dollars. Measure S is a \$270 million dollar general obligation bond passed by the voters in April 2011 to build, renovate and improve schools in the Glendale Unified School District.

The new 2-story classroom building is 22,976 square feet with solar panels on the roof and consists of 16 classrooms. The groundbreaking for this project took place last year on March 26, 2015. Cost for the project was approximately \$10.2 million.
