### Defining Cyberbullying

2007

#### [Act 115](#)

To define bullying and to Include cyberbullying in public school district Anti-bullying policies.

### Establishment of the Crime of Cyberbullying 2011

#### [Act 905](#)

Establishes the crime of cyberbullying, the electronic transmission of severe, hostile and repeated communication to another person with the purpose to coerce, intimidate, harass or cause emotional distress; a Class B misdemeanor.
