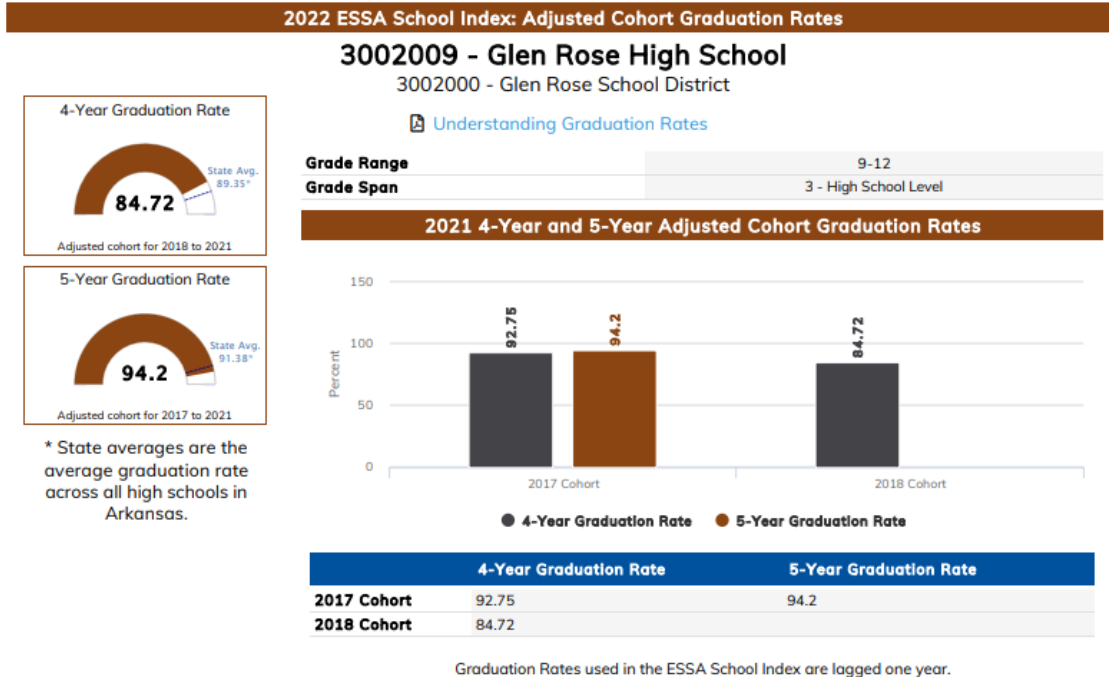

62 students took the ACT in spring of 2022

We have put the following interventions in place to address deficiencies.

1. GR Read (new last year) - We are still trying to increase reading across the board in the high school. The GR Read program we implemented last year seemed to be a success. Students like being able to choose their book (in their level) and not having to worry about points. We are still working toward changing the reading culture and instill a love for reading in all students. Wednesdays are still Stop, Drop, and Read in LEAP class.
2. LEAP - a 45 minute period utilized for small group/teacher interaction. LEAP is being used to remediate students based on their scores. Upper level LEAP classes are being used for ACT prep and practical life skills. Students are still instructed to check email and grades. Wednesdays are still reserved for Stop, Drop, and Read.
3. PLC meetings occur for content area teachers and grade level teachers. The purpose of these meetings are to be proactive with students and planning among other things. These meetings occur at least once a month. Meetings are added as needed throughout the school year. Academic concerns, general concerns for students, procedures, content being taught are just a few items that are discussed at these meetings.
4. Data measurement tools - NWEA Interim Testing and IXL Diagnostic are both being used to steer classroom instruction and to help place and remediate students.
5. The English department will be working with Dawson Co-op literacy specialist on developing essential standards.
