STUDENT TRANSFERS (REGULATION)

The rapid growth of the Gore Public Schools has made it extremely difficult to provide adequate classroom facilities for all the students in the district. As a result of this rapid growth, it has become necessary to restrict the number of transfers into the district beginning with the 2014 school year.

- 1. Beginning with the 2014 school year, student transfers will be granted only to those students who received a regular or emergency transfer for the previous school year or if adequate space is available. Students who received a transfer during the previous school year will be allowed to continue their formal education until graduation or until they have a break in tenure with the schools.
- 2. Parents who have been granted a transfer to a school age child during the previous school year will be allowed to receive a transfer for a younger child that is not of school age if the non-school age child was listed on the transferred child's transfer form. This is an effort to maintain family integrity.
- 3. Transfer forms will be initiated by the office of the superintendent for those parents or guardians who have a transfer on file for a school age child. No other transfers will be granted to school age children living outside the legal boundaries of the school district beginning with the 2014school year.
- 4. School age children who have been legal residents of the school district and have attended three consecutive years during the time of legal residency will be eligible for a transfer into the district should the parent(s) or guardian(s) relocate outside the legal boundaries.
- 5. Parents or guardians who seek a transfer from outside the legal boundaries of the school district are responsible for the student's transportation needs or cost.
- 6. This policy does not affect student transfers for those students who legally reside in the district but who want to transfer to another school in the district.
- 7. A student who resides in the district but wishes to attend a school in another school district will not be affected by this policy.
- 8. Not withstanding the above, employees of this school system will be given the opportunity to transfer their children into this district if they live outside the school district boundaries.
