REASON FOR REPRIMAND: _____

Students will be reprimanded for:

1. Possession of candy, gum, or sunflower seeds at school. Teachers may give candy for treats to be eaten in their classrooms.
2. Horseplay and roughhousing.
3. Boys and girls not keeping their hands to themselves.
4. Failure to bring needed materials to class (books, paper, pencil, etc.).
5. Failure to keep belongings in the assigned locker. Students may not use locker tops, floors, or desks (excluding fifth graders in their classroom).
6. Rudeness to a teacher or fellow student.
7. Misbehaving in the cafeteria, in the bathroom, on the playground, or at a ball game.
8. Use of obscene or inappropriate language or gestures.
9. Running in the hall or on the sidewalks.
10. Being in the classroom before school or at the noon hour without the teacher's permission.
11. Failure to use the back sidewalk to the playground or gym at noon.
12. Being in the lower grade bathrooms.
13. Any reason for which a teacher determines a reprimand is deserved.
