Bus and school transportation:

Bus Drivers-

Hand sanitizer will be on each bus at footwell. Make sure you have it in place during pretrip inspection. Every student will hand sanitize before entrancing past driver seat. You will scan each student's temp while they are doing this. If they are less than 100.4, they may enter and be seated. MASKS ARE REQUIRED to be worn at all times while on buses; DRIVERS INCLUDED.

****IF A STUDENT HAS A TEMP of 100.4 or greater, they will be sent back home if there is someone there for them. If you don't know if there is someone home for them, or if there is no one there, they are to be seated as close to front as possible with no other student and with a same household member.

- Isolated Student protocol:
 Driver is to notify the duty person that you have student(s) that has to have a parent contacted and not be allowed to mix with general populations. This will be done before unloading others.
 Wipe that seat (s) down before unloading other.
- DURING NORMAL TRAVEL, WINDOWS MUST BE OPEN!!! Inclimate weather; leave windows open as much as possible, keep fans running.

REGUARDLESS OF A/C, WINDOWS MUST BE OPEN OR EVERYONE ON BUS WILL HAVE TO BE QUARANTINED if someone tests positive!! THIS IS STATE HEALTH DEPT RULE.

Buses are to be wiped down, top of seats, as you do your final check before you leave after each trip. No eating or drinking on buses until further notice.

Assign seats. Make a list so we know who was where if we have a COVID case on a bus.
If a student bounces, removes mask, or will not keep their hands to themselves, they
will be warned once and then rider privileges revoked for 14 days. Report any violations
to principals upon arrival at school. Parent will then be contacted and informed that if
their student cannot stay in assigned seat, they will lose bus riding privileges.

Family or household members shall be seated together as much as possible and/or by their household members' seats.

PARENTS: PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR STUDENT BUS RIDER HAS A MASK DAILY. CHECK THEM FOR TEMPERATURE (100.4 or greater) BEFORE YOU SEND THE TO THE BUS!!! See above**** as to protocol if a student has a temp. and you are not there to take them home.
