## AP French Language and Culture

(1 year – 1 credit)

Offered to: Grades 11-12

Prerequisite: Successful completion of French 3

The AP French course contains 10 units divided into two semesters. Every 2-3 weeks, a new subtheme will be introduced within the 6 themes required by the College Board. Within that theme, the students will work on all aspects of communication: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Activities will include the three modes of communication: interpretive, interpersonal and presentational. Student work will also be continually assessed based on various writing and speaking assignments which are graded according to the AP guidelines. In addition, a final assessment will be given at the end of each theme. Each unit will be based on an overall theme and highlights a specific Francophone country or region of the French-speaking world. Each unit will be divided into either two or three smaller lessons, each of which contains approximately thirty to forty different activities, practices, and assessments for students to participate in and complete.

## **BROADCASTING TECHNOLOGY**

(1/2 year - 1/2 Credit)

Recommended after the completion of Digital Video effects, and Computer Graphics 1 and 2

Broadcasting Technology courses provide students with the knowledge and skills to produce television broadcast programs. Typically, students prepare and produce short programs, learning the technical aspects of the operation and how to evaluate programming and assess audience reaction and impact.
