MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL ELECTION MEETING AND BUDGET VOTE, MAY 15, 2012

The Annual Election and Budget Vote Meeting of May 15, 2012 was called to order at 11:40 a.m. by Maryann Viglucci, so appointed by the Board of Education as Chairperson, at their Regular Meeting of February 15, 2012.

Mrs. Viglucci led the inspectors in the Pledge of Allegiance. She announced the Emergency Procedure Drill and instructed those in attendance where to exit the building in case of an emergency. The District Clerk administered the Oath of Office to the Chief Inspector, Chairperson, and Inspectors of Election.

Mrs. Viglucci announced that the District Clerk, Barbara Muller, will serve as Clerk of the Meeting as provided in Education Law.

The District Clerk announced that the purpose of this meeting is as follows:

1. To elect three members of the Board of Education for the Harborfields Central School District.
2. To consider and vote upon the annual school district budget proposition #1 in the amount of \$75,134,670 for the 2012-13 school year which was adopted by the Board of Education in accordance with Education Law and the necessary taxes therefore be levied upon the taxable property of said school district.

Ms. Muller advised that the Notice of the Budget Hearing and Election has been published four times in The Long Islander and Times of Huntington March 29, 2012, April 12, 2012, April 26, 2012, and May 10, 2012.

A motion was made by Janice Perdikoylis, seconded by Barbara Hanna, and carried unanimously, to dispense with the reading of the "Official Notice."

The District Clerk read the qualifications of a voter.

1. A citizen of the United States
2. 18 years of age or older
3. District resident for the past 30 days

The District Clerk announced that the Board of Education had appointed, and notification in writing had been sent to the Chief Inspector and the following Inspectors of Election:

*These inspectors are certified by the Suffolk County Board of Elections as required to use the new scanner machines.

At the March 21, 2012 Board of Education meeting, the Board authorized the District Clerk to hire additional inspectors of election if necessary.

The chairperson announced that a list of all persons to whom an absentee ballot has been sent is on file in the office of the District Clerk. The voting tabulators were inspected by the Chairperson, the Chief Inspector, and the District Clerk. The District Clerk made a note of the serial numbers and ran a zero tape for each tabulator.

At 12:00 P.M. (E.D.S.T.), Mrs. Viglucci declared that the polls were open.

At 9:55 P.M. (E.D.S.T.), Mrs. Viglucci announced that the doors of the polling place would be closed at 10:00 P.M. All persons within the polling place would have an opportunity to vote. At 10:00 P.M. the doors were closed and the polls declared closed.

The Chairperson, District Clerk, and Mr. Toles opened the voting tabulators and obtained the closing poll tape to ascertain the results of the voting. Additionally, the absentee ballots were opened, counted, and recorded on the official tally sheet. The results of the election were filled in on the forms provided.

It was requested that there be silence in the auditorium while the closing poll tape was removed from each voting tabulator. The Chairperson read the vote count on each closing poll tape in a voice loud enough so that all persons in the voting room could hear the results. Mrs. Viglucci then stated that the results of the Annual Budget Vote and election are not official until all close poll tapes and absentee ballots have been tallied and double-checked.

Mrs. Viglucci then announced the official results of the election.

Maggie Boba received a total of 1,379 votes

Donald Mastroianni received a total of 1,531 votes

Dr. Thomas McDonagh received a total of 1,564 votes

Louis Voltaggio received a total of 1,051 votes

Mrs. Viglucci announced the official results. Proposition #1 was declared adopted. Mrs. Boba, Mr. Mastroianni, and Dr. McDonagh were declared to be elected to three-year terms on the Board of Education.

Mrs. Viglucci adjourned the meeting at 10:30 p.m.
