Structure of a Writing Lesson

Mini Lesson

- Explicit instruction
- Modeling of the skill/strategy
- o Gradual release of responsibility- "I do", "You do", "We do"
- Turn and talk with a partner to practice the skill/strategy

• Independent Work

- Students work independently
- Students are at various stages of the writing process (thinking, planning, revising, edit, or publishing)
- Small group instruction or 1:1 conferencing

Share

Students share a skill or craft they added to their writing

The Writing Process
















What is Fountas & Pinnell Classroom?

Fountas & Pinnell Classroom[™] (FPC) is a cohesive, multi-text approach to literacy instruction for all students in grades PreK–6. The system is designed to support **whole-group**, **small-group** and **independent** learning opportunities including:

- Interactive Read-Aloud
- Reading Mini Lessons
- Phonics, Spelling, and Word Study
- Guided Reading
- Book Clubs








Interactive Read Aloud



- An interactive experience in which readers are engaged in discussing a text throughout the reading.
- An opportunity to deepen comprehension through discourse and active thinking.
- Develops stronger vocabulary by hearing new words in new context.











Reading Mini Lessons



- Concise, purposeful lessons with practical application in a specific area of literacy.
- Engages readers in inquiry that leads to discovery and understanding of a general principle.
- Lessons grow out of the interactive read-aloud and are linked to independent reading.

• Same structure of a writing mini lesson: mini lesson, independent work and, share.






Guided Reading

- Small group instruction grouped by similar reading behaviors and instructional levels.
- Students develop fundamental skills necessary for proficient reading.
- Builds fluency, expands vocabulary and deepens comprehension.












Phonics, Spelling & Word Study


• Purpose: expand and refine students' reading & writing competencies.

 Explicit lessons for whole group and small group application that help students attend to, learn about, and efficiently use sounds, letters and

words.











Book Clubs - Grade 5



- Deepens readers' appreciation and understanding of a common text.
- Extends students' thinking as they process and interpret the perspectives and opinions of peers.
- Provides an authentic context for applying norms for listening and thinking.
- Expands students' ability to express their ideas orally using academic language.

The goal of all reading is the joyful, independent, and meaningful processing of a written text.









Summary
