Innovation:

The Board of Education, in collaboration with the Superintendent and his team, will:

- Support the implementation of the newly developed [Harborfields Strategic Plan](#) through the allocation of district resources to achieve the stated goals of creating a connected community of learners, supporting social-emotional wellness for all students and staff, and expanding real world learning opportunities.
- Seek opportunities to build upon recently completed school security projects through a careful evaluation of district operations. This evaluation will identify potential enhancements to existing school security and safety plans and staff training programs.
- Effectively improve upon all tools of communication to enhance school-home communication in order to promote the highest levels of family engagement in our schools in support of all students.

Curriculum:

The Board of Education, in collaboration with the Superintendent and his team, will:

- Support student career and college readiness choice through their engagement in rigorous and relevant academic programs by promoting all graduation pathways including the Arts, Career and Technical Education (CTE), Career Development and Occupational Studies (CDOS), Civics, Humanities, Science and Mathematics (STEM), and World Languages.

Finance:

The Board of Education, in collaboration with the Superintendent and his team, will:

- Continue to allocate resources to support high levels of student engagement in academic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular school activities.
- Support the implementation of the approved Energy Performance Contract to leverage energy cost savings to fund additional capital upgrades to district facilities while continuing to support projects approved in the 2019 Capital Bond Referendum.
- Support the maintenance of District facilities through short-term and long-term budget planning to support the 5-year food service equipment replacement/facilities maintenance plan.
