Since all courses offered at the middle school do not meet for an equal amount of time during the school year, I have attached an explanation of the time requirement for each course and the formula used to calculate your student's grade point average. Courses that meet every day count as a full value, whereas alternate day courses count as half value. Music courses such as band, orchestra, and chorus also receive half value.
