This course is designed to teach students to be successful mathematical problem solvers. It is a continuation of algebraic and geometric concepts developed in Algebra I and Geometry. Some topics covered will include: introduction to functions; absolute value functions, equations, and inequalities; systems of linear equations and inequalities; rational exponents; quadratic relations; square root functions and equations; cube and cube root functions and equations; rational functions and equations; exponential functions and equations; logarithmic functions and equations; and linear, quadratic, and exponential data models.

Required Supplies (DAILY):

You are required to bring the following supplies to class every day:

- pencils
