- History
- History and Appreciation of Visual and Performing Arts
- Electives

ACADEMIC PROGRESS and ATTENDANCE

Successful completion of the program is dependent upon regular attendance and progress. Meeting with an administrator, the student will produce a schedule that best reflects his/her anticipated days and hours of attendance. Students are to attend the Academy a minimum of 3 hours/day, five days a week. Students who accumulate three (3) unexcused absence/tardy events will be given notice of being truant. At six (6) unexcused events, the student will be placed on probation and will be contacted by the Academy staff. If a student accumulates nine (9) unexcused events, the student will be dismissed from the Hopkins County Schools Academy. Excused events are defined in the Hopkins County Schools Code of Student Conduct.
