What is a DFP?

A District Facilities Plan is a comprehensive review and evaluation of a school district's facilities that is prepared every four years. This evaluation is undertaken by a Local Planning Committee with the assistance of the district administrative staff, architects, engineers, KDE and other consultants.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THIS AMENDED DFP?

NO TAX INCREASE

The plan, even with its improvements, will not create an educational tax increase to pay for these improvements:
No increase of taxes

A NEW SCHOOL WITHOUT THE NEW SCHOOL COST

The plan will create a new learning environment without having to pay for a new school

The PK-8 model works and creates a family culture of continuity

ENVIRONMENTAL AND STRUCTURAL ENHANCEMENTS

The traffic issues around the enhanced schools can be improved
