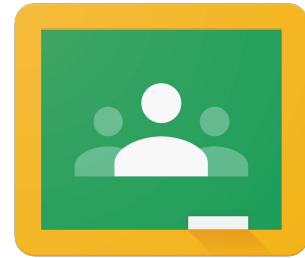

The Point System

- We operate on a point system.
