

# 2020-2021 State Immunization Requirements for Students K-12

Students will NOT be allowed to start school without proof of updated shot record.

For students with an “Affidavit of Exemption for Reasons of Conscience” it must be an original, notarized and unexpired.

(Each affidavit is valid for 2 years from the date it is notarized)

## FOR INCOMING 7TH GRADERS

**ALL** students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2019-2020 school year must receive state mandated immunizations prior to the first day of school. All incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders must have the following vaccines:

~**Tdap/Td booster**: 1 dose if at least 5 years has passed since the last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine.

~**Meningococcal (MCV4)**: 1 dose of MCV4 is required on or after the students 11<sup>th</sup> birthday. Note: If a student received the vaccine at 10 years of age, this will satisfy the requirement.
