## How does the STAR Program work?

Students will be rewarded depending on their level of academic achievement:

### Oiler Card

0.33 GPA Increase from previous Qtr.

### The Orange Card

3.4-3.83 GPA

### The Black Card

4.0 GPA

Any of the above cards are valid for one quarter. New cards will be issued after each quarter, based on the level earned.

\*If card is lost, a new card will NOT be issued
