## ADVANCED BAND (Band 3-4)

Dwyer's Band earned Unanimous Superior ratings in both Performance and Sight-Reading at their 2017 SCSBOA Festival.
Advanced Band is a full-year elective for students who play woodwind, brass, and percussion instruments. Our ensemble plays challenging arrangements in a variety of genres. We participate in several concerts and events throughout the academic year such as festivals hosted by the Southern California School Band \& Orchestra Association, and an annual Disneyland Performing Arts Workshop.

Students not accepted into this group will be placed in Beginning/Intermediate Band (Band 1-2).

## Students will be expected to present the following during their audition:

## Brass and Woodwind Instrumentalists:

- A 2 minute or less excerpt of your choice which best demonstrates your musical and technical ability
- One or two octaves of these Major Scales (memorization optional):
- C Instruments (Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, Trombone, Baritone, Tuba): Bb, F, Eb, Ab
- B-Flat Instruments (Clarinet, Tenor Sax, Trumpet): C, G, F, Bb
- E-Flat Instruments (Alto/Bari Sax): G, D, C, F
- French Horn: F, C, Bb, Eb
- Specific melodies for your chosen instrument. Sheet music is available at dms.schoolloop.com/music or in the Dwyer Music Room B-4.
- Choose one of the following three:
- March Militaire
- On Top of Old Smokey
- School Spirit
- Mandatory melody:
- Woodwinds: Eine Kleine Nachtmusik by Mozart
- Brass: Theme from Symphony No. 1 by Brahms
- Sight-reading: melodies may include rhythms incorporating whole, half, quarter, eighth, dotted half, and dotted quarter notes, as well as equivalent rests


## Concert Percussionists:

Percussionists in Concert Band will be expected to play both pitched and unpitched instruments. A bell kit, mallets, snare, and drum sticks will be provided if needed or students may bring their own equipment. Thus, there will be two audition components, which will consist of:

- Mallets:
- A 2 minute or less excerpt of your choice which best demonstrates your musical and technical ability
- One or two octaves of each of these Major Scales (memorization optional): Bb, F, Eb, Ab
- Melody for Can-Can by Offenbach. Sheet music is available online at dms.schoolloop.com/music or in the Dwyer Music Room B-4
- Sight-reading: melodies may include rhythms incorporating whole, half, quarter, eighth, dotted half, and dotted quarter notes, as well as equivalent rests
- Snare:
- Demonstrate 8 beats of each of the following rudiments: flam, flam tap, drag, single paradiddle (eighth and/or sixteenth), $5-, 9$ - and 13 -stroke roll.
- Sight-reading: melodies may include rhythms incorporating whole, half, quarter, eighth, dotted half, and dotted quarter notes, as well as equivalent rests, and rudiments mentioned above
