Membership Expectations




- Scholarship:
 - > 3.75-4.0 GPA
 - No "Us" or "Ns" in citizenship for the first three quarters of the current year
 - No suspensions, discipline demerits, or expulsions during the current school year.

Membership Expectations Cont.



- Service to Community
 - Current 8th graders need a minimum of 18 hours by May 17th.
 - Current 7th graders need a minimum of 18 hours logged by May 17th each year for a total of 36 hours at the end of 8th grade.
 - Document all service hours using Dwyer NJHS Go Card (must complete a hard copy community service form first)- Service hours for NJHS may not be used for other service organizations.
