Your student's height (including shoes) and weight must be clearly stated on the form. This helps the gown company properly size the gown. Families that already have a gown from a previous promotion do not need to purchase a new gown - select Package Two on the order form.

# **Important Promotion Information:**

#### Parking

Parking will be extremely limited. Parking is available at First Christian Church and the surrounding streets. Please extend courtesy to our Dwyer and Smith neighbors. Note Dwyer and Smith students will be released from school at the time when guests will be arriving. There will be handicapped parking available at the Dwyer Gymnasium parking lot.

#### Seating

Family members and guests may enter the Dwyer grounds for seating beginning at 1:35 PM on June 23, 2023. The ceremony will be held on the lawn directly in front of the school. **Please do not arrive prior to that time; security will ask you to leave.** A family member may hold up to **six** seats maximum by sitting in the seats starting at 1:35 PM. Handicap seating will be available on first come first serve basis. It is only available for the handicapped person and one accompanied caregiver.
