

Eligibility: Students identified as English learner and immigrant student

Designated English Language Development (ELD)

K-8 grades \rightarrow 30 minutes or more of instruction provided during the regular school day for focused instruction on the state-adopted ELD standards to assist English learners to develop critical English language skills necessary for academic content learning in English



Integrated English Language Development (ELD)

K-8 grades \rightarrow instruction in which the state-adopted ELD standards are used in tandem with the state-adopted academic content standards
