CLASS TITLE: ADAPTIVE PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Principal, identify motor functioning deficits of students and provide a specially designed program to meet the needs of the individual.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Provide specially designed physical education to individuals with exceptional needs who are unable to benefit from regular or modified physical education activities. **E2**

Identify motor functioning development deficits of students and design instructional strategies to meet or accommodate the needs of the students. **E2**

Participate as a member of the IEP team and develop long- and short-term goals and implement appropriate activities to meet the needs of students. **E3**

Participate as a member of a multi-disciplinary assessment team in the assessment, diagnosis, and placement of special education students as necessary; serve as a resource to the District to consult and provide direct services for students who exhibit significant problems of motor functioning. **E1**

Communicate with staff and parents to coordinate activities and facilitate the progress of students. **E1**

Perform related duties as assigned.

- Basic record-keeping techniques.
- Correct English usage, grammar, spelling, punctuation and vocabulary.
- Oral and written communication skills.

- Diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of District students.

Ability To:

- Make generalizations, evaluations or decisions without immediate supervision.
- Maintain current knowledge of technological advances in the field.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Prepare and deliver oral presentations.
- Establish and maintain cooperative and effective working relationships with others.
- Maintain records and prepare reports.
- Prioritize and schedule work.
- Read, interpret, apply and explain rules, regulations, policies and procedures.
- Maintain current knowledge of technological advances in the field.
- Complete work with many interruptions.
- Determine appropriate action within clearly defined guidelines.
- Understand and work within scope of authority.
- Work independently with little direction.
- Meet schedules and time lines.
- Observe health and safety regulations.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Environment:

- Classroom environment.
- Considerable distraction from classroom activities.

Physical Abilities:

- Hearing and speaking to exchange information and make classroom presentations.
- Sitting or standing for extended periods of time.
- Reaching overhead, above the shoulders and horizontally.
- Bending at the waist.
- Seeing to read and explain classroom assignments.
