RE: CALENDAR Memorandum of Understanding Tentative Agreement

The Huntington Beach City School District (District) and Huntington Beach Elementary Teachers Association (Association) mutually agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and agree to the following:

On September 29, 2022, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill 1655 that added June 19 (Juneteenth) as a state holiday, a day of public school closure. From the Office of the Governor to the members of the California State Assembly, Governor Newsom wrote, "Juneteenth is a federal holiday that commemorates the emancipation of African American slaves. It is a time of remembrance of the cruelty of slavery, celebration of the abolishment of slavery, pride in the profound contributions of African Americans and a time for reflection of how we can each contribute to a more just society."

Education Code 37220(e) allows for Governing Boards by Resolution to revise the date upon which the schools of the district close in observance of any of the holidays identified in subdivision (a).


