- ⁷ Final dose of PCV series should be given at ≥12 months of age or after. ⁸ The 4th dose of DTaP may be administered as early as 12 months, provided at least 6 months have elapsed since the 3^{8D} DTaP dose.
- ⁹ HPV vaccine should be given on a 0, 6-12 month schedule for 9-14 year olds (min. interval is 5 months). If patient is immunocompromised or initiates series at 15 years or older, use a 3 dose schedule (0, 1-2, 6 months).
- ¹⁰ A MenB vaccine series may be given to all persons 16 through 23 years of gae. See MMWR for details.
- ¹¹ Two doses given at least 4 weeks apart are recommended for ages 6 months-8 years who are getting flu vaccine for the first time. IMM-395 (3/17)
