Hello, Jacket Families!

It was a great first two days of school! We are so excited to see our 5th & 6th graders and welcome our new 4th graders, as well as our new Yellowjackets!! I know it's going to be a great year, but after reflecting on the first two days, we need your help with a few things!

- Our doors open at 7:30, and the first bell is at 7:45. The TARDY BELL rings at 7:50.
- If you are at the front of the line before the doors open, please be considerate of those people behind you that have already allowed their students to exit their cars and sit outside. Please do not block them in. Please be willing to either pull up, or loop back around, or go ahead and let your kids out as well, so those grown ups can get on their way. Thank you for your teamwork in this matter.
- Please do NOT drop students off in the bus loop area. This is incredibly unsafe as our students
 have been seen darting between busses. Additionally, the doors are locked as soon as the last
 bus drops off. We do not want our students locked out.
- Please do NOT drop students off in the street in front of the school. Again, this is INCREDIBLY
 unsafe and actually creates delays for those people following our rules and procedures.
 Please pull through the carline.
- Students should exit their cars as soon as they stop at the sidewalk in the parking lot and walk up to the front. Please do not wait to get to the front, as this also creates delays.
- We are working on a plan to improve and speed up afternoon carline. Thank you for your patience.



- Most Fridays we will have either \$1 ice cream or \$1 popcorn. We typically send a remind the
 night before to let everyone know. If it is easier for you to prepay for several weeks at a time,
 you can send \$\$ to the office in an envelope with your student's name & "popcorn" on the
 outside, and we will keep track up to \$20 at a time. That will get you through the first semester
 or longer.
- We have added a drop off table for lunches and other items. Please label your items, and we'll
 make sure they are delivered. This will save us time and limit disruptions to instruction time.
 MONEY should always be brought in to the office, not left on the table.
- We can no longer administer over the counter medication (such as Ibuprofen or Tylenol). If a student needs this medication during the day, their grown up will have to come up to administer it. Thank you for understanding.

I also want to share that every morning at the KUE, our students will recite the KUE CARES pledge. I want to take this opportunity to share this with all of our families:

At the KUE, WE CARE!
We CHOOSE responsibly
We ACT respectfully
We REFLECT constantly
And we ENGAGE IN LEARNING!
This is how we BEHAVE WITH CARE!

For those of you who haven't had the opportunity to get to know me, I'm a very "open door" kind of person. If I'm available, I will always visit with our students' grownups. I'm also very reachable by email and phone. When you have concerns, please reach out to me. Let's make it a great year by keeping those communication lines open.
