- ✓ 4 years English
- ✓ 3 years Math: Math 1A + Math 1B or Math 1, Math 2, Math 3 (4 yrs. recommended)
- ✓ 2 years History/Social Science
- ✓ 2 years Lab Science (3 yrs. recommended)
- ✓ 2 years Foreign Language (3 yrs. recommended)



University (CSU/UC) A-G Requirements

✓ 1 year Visual/Performing Arts

✓ 1 year College Prep Elective-many options

Other requirements:

✓ “C” grade or higher in all A-G coursework

*SAT/ACT not used for admissions but can be useful.

- Review academic + SAT/ACT requirements
- Inform the senior counselor **early**
- **Application due dates vary, \$ fees vary**

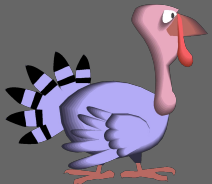
