### Message from Mr. Henry:

The building is open but are a couple of requirements to entrance for everyone's safety. The building has been cleaned and sanitized for the upcoming school year.

#### Below is the following requirements to enter building:

- 1.) The main entrance will be the **ONLY unlocked** door for entering the building.
- 2.) When you enter and leave the building, you MUST sign-in and sign-out.
- 3.) You **MUST** have an appointment prior to entering the building.
- 4.) Myself or an office secretary will check your temperature and you will answer COVID questions prior to admittance into the building.
- 5.) You **MUST** wear a mask as you enter the building and wear it anytime that you are in the building
- 6.) There **MUST** be social distancing of 6 feet observed in the building.

### Ki-Be Remote Learning 2.0 to Start

- o It is decision driven by the Health District
- o It will be much improved from the Spring
- Attendance and engagement will be mandatory.
- Elementary students will have morning meetings with their teachers and then recorded learning sessions each day
- Secondary (MS & HS) students will have 2 to 3 live meetings daily and additional recorded sessions

Q: For classes like woodshop what will those students do?

A: Classes like Woodshop, welding, cooking, art, etc. is all going to be up to the teachers. They will be figuring all of that out and will be communicated to students and families.

Q: Our household were told that the schedule for High School would not be the same as younger kids as we need a computer from school and we were told only 1 would be provided for the family. We have a 3rd grader who has to be on earlier in day and a high schooler so how will that work with classes being scattered on different days?

A: Elementary and High School schedules are not at the same time so your child will be able to access classes at the correct times. Please keep in mind that your child will be graded based off of being available normal 8am-3pm expectation. We do understand certain circumstance may change that but communication with teachers and staff will need to be made before hand.

Q: What about our children in IEP classes?

A: There will have to be IEP reviews for all students who had an IEP last school year. Modifications will need to be made because of remote learning. We are looking into if the health department releases new information as to if students are able to meet in small groups, that life skills students, EL & Migrant students, and other students with specific needs and accommodations would be one of the first to come back into the building.

There will be an Sped department zoom next week so please look out for that being sent to you.

Q: Will hardback textbooks be available for the students?

A: Yes, checking out those text books will go thru each teacher that has them. The pickup of those books will most likely be a drive up pick up with minimal contact. Wait for contact on your students teacher on how exactly that will look.

Q: Will assignments be given daily and due daily or once a week?

A: This is based off of each teacher and each class.

Q: What about kids that are doing afternoon Tri-tech classes? How will that work?

A: From my understanding Tri-Tech is also virtual so contacting Tri-Tech first will be important to confirm what that looks like for that school. Make sure there is communication with all teachers regarding your each of your schedules. Also, there is an option for recorded videos of lessons so if student has to watch at a different time that is an option. Again, communication is key.

Q: I am not receiving school messenger calls or emails from the HS, can you look into this?

A: Yes, we are currently looking into why parents/guardians are not getting call or emails. This should be fixed by the next time information goes out.

Q: In the last information call you guys mentioned that pre-K through 12 grade would have the option of going to school completely online in "home school" environment.

A: Yes, that is an option. Like I said before there is still quite a bit of undetermined information but the programs used are between Apex or Ingenuity. There is no deadline as of now but we will look into that as well we are speaking about this being a Semester or 1 full school year commitment.

Q : Are we starting with zoom and then transitioning to teams?

A: Yes.

Q: How will band class work? Will there be an online course?

A: Yes, band will be online. How that looks is up to Mr. Mendell.

Q: What happens to students that were scheduled to be in the transitions program? (IEP student work program)

A: We're not sure if transitions will be happening but if it does juniors and seniors will have first access. If we are able we will provide transportation like in the past.

Q: What if you have 2 in high school and 1 computer?

A: The High School is 1 to 1. Each student will have a computer (desktop or laptop).

\*edit this will be a rolling start to get all HS students a desktop or laptop.

Q: What about the families with no internet?

A: The state has asked us to contact all students and families to ask about internet and learning devices in the home. As of right now we don't have a plan for this. We have talked about putting up drive-up Wi-Fi, mobile hotspots, etc. As soon as we know we will give out that information.

Q: Will FFA be meeting?

A: Yes, via Zoom or Teams.

Q: How do we know which teachers our high schoolers have?

A: Schedule will be accessible next week.

Q: What if a student needs to ask a teacher a question about assignment in beginning of the week but gets no response until Friday???

A: The teachers will work hard for that not to happen. They have office hours before "class" starts so this will be a perfect time for answering questions as well as Fridays.

Q: Will progress reports be available daily, weekly or monthly?

A: You are able to access your child(ren)'s grade via Skyward every day. As to being updated that differs from each teacher. Contact your child's teacher if you ever have questions.

Q: Where are we getting our schedules?

A: Students can access them on Skyward. More information will be going out

Q : Are standards going to be set for students to be required to be on video so they are not just signing into class and then playing video games the whole time?

A: Yes, video must be on and mic must be accessible.

Q: Using Teams - are teachers going to be directed to a similar set of requirements? Such as using Teams to send/receive and grades, or using Skyward, or other forms of communication?

A: Grades will be posted by teachers in Skyward. There isn't a specific form of communication required for teachers but email, phone, video, teams and skyward are all an option.

Q: Will internet issues affect my child's grade?

A: No, but there does need to be communication to the teacher that there is issues.

Q: Are we still required to submit an Authorization for Administration of Oral Medication at School?

A: Not until students are in the building.

Q: Is there a capability for students to submit assignments via online text books? And when will students receive the information to access these online texts?

A: We're not sure if students will be able to submit assignments via online text books. I believe assignments will be submitted in teams. The teacher will give access on how to access online text books (if available).

Q: So do we wait even if we do not get a call or email for IEP?

A: After the Zoom we will have a better idea on what the next steps for IEP's are. If you don't receive any contact after school starts I would then contact the Sped department.

Q: I received a notice of final forms stating my child's physical examination will be will be expiring. Do we submit a new physical examination?

A: We won't need physicals until/if sports ever start but if you have it and want to drop it off in the office that's fine. See the guidelines above.

Q: When do we turn in computers?

A: End of school year.

Q:What about sports?

A: As of now there is no athletics. If we are able to start sports WIAA does have a plan on how that looks and information will go out about that if the time comes.

Q: How do we get help from the teachers?

A: Teachers will communicating to their student's about ways for the student to reach out to them with questions and concerns.

Q: If the students are turning in their work and understanding the lessons, will they be docked participation for not logging onto teams? Are the team meetings mandatory?

A: No they will not be docked for participation. The expectation is that your student will be available to be on for all designated class periods. If that isn't possible for some reason then there will need to be some form of communication on when and why student will be missing live team sessions.

Q: When will freshman orientation be? Is there a set date?

A: A big freshman orientation won't happen until/if we get back in the building but the counselors are posting orientations, information, and tutorials for all grades.

A: Yes.

Q: What do we need to get for supplies?

A: If items are need they will be provided by school.

Q: How will get our laptops?

A: You will be contacted on how to get the laptop.

Q: Is all of this info the same as the middle school? We missed the middle school meeting.

A: It is similar but I would recommend going to the Middle School to verify.

Q: How will we get our work from teachers?

A: Teams. All information on how to log in and access Teams will be sent out.
