POLICY TITLE: HOMEBOUND SERVICES (IDEA) POLICY NO: 657

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Homebound services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act means services that are delivered in the home setting (or other agreed upon setting, such as a hospital) in accordance with the child's individualized education program (IEP). The decision to place a student in a homebound setting, the services to be provided and delivery of services shall be made by the student's IEP team in accordance with applicable law.

ATTENDANCE

Students who are on homebound instruction will be included in calculating average daily attendance.
