

KSD Capital Mitigation Fee

- Important Notes:
 - Analysis uses capital expansion fee best practices
 - Conservative assumptions
 - Student generation rates, capital costs, attributed infrastructure
 - Results represent districtwide averages

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Student Generation Rates

- US Census Public Use Microdata (PUM)
- Survey area includes Kuna, south Boise, and southern Ada County
 - May underestimate rates because of demographics in Boise
- Analysis excluded pre-k students, homeschool/private school students


