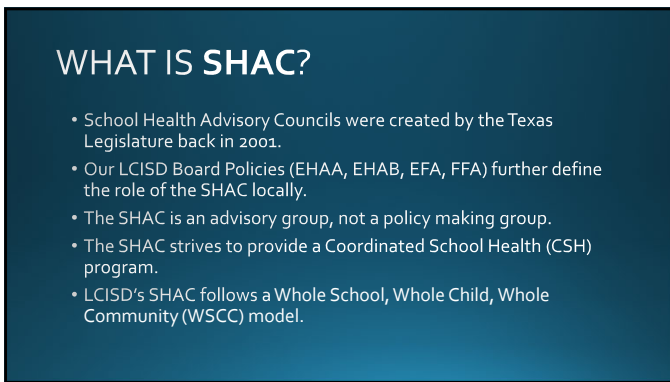
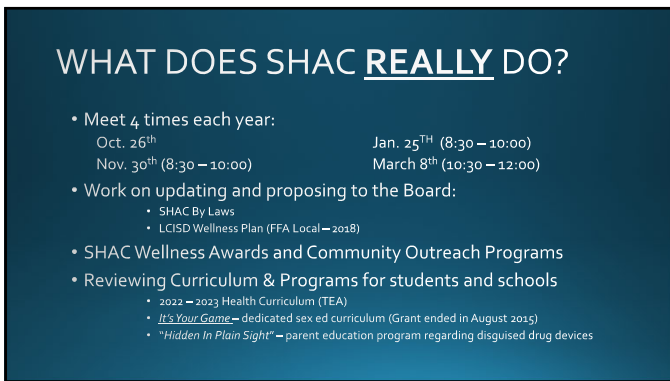

- Work with other committees as needed

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EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

•SECRETARY:

- Preside over meetings in absence of Chair and Vice-Chair
- Work with coordinator to prepare meeting notices, minutes and handouts
- Assist the Coordinator with the annual report to the Board in the Spring

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Update LCISD SHAC By-Laws

- LCISD SHAC has by-laws that were updated in Spring of 2019
- Our by-laws need to be updated again to reflect the most current legislation
- We can also update our by-laws to reflect our updated structure and operating procedures
- Updated by-laws will be voted on at the November SHAC meeting after being drafted and reviewed by committee

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Curriculum Recommendations

- Health education curriculum (textbooks/resources) for grades K – 12 will need to be recommended to the Board this Spring.
- If the Board adopts a resolution directing the SHAC to do so, we will need to recommend curriculum for Human Sexuality Instruction. (This will include 2 public meetings before making our recommendation.)

- Meet in November (Zoom) with curriculum team for 30 minutes.
- Review proposed curriculums
- Meet in March (Zoom) with curriculum team to discuss and vote on recommended Health Curriculum for LCISD.
